

Setup - Single Link / Single Video





Remote Unit



Connect:

- DVI MM cable from the computer's DVI out to the local units DVI in port
- USB Type A to Type B cable from the computer's USB port to the local units USB port
- DVI monitor USB keyboard and USB mouse to the remote unit.
 - USB peripherals to the remote unit
- CATx cables (2) from the local unit to the remote unit
- Power adapters to the local and remote unit

Setup - Single Link / Dual Video







Connect:

- DVI MM cables (2) from the computer's DVI out to the local units DVI in port
- USB Type A to Type B cable from the computer's USB port to the local units USB port
- DVI monitor (2), USB keyboard and USB mouse to the remote unit.
- USB peripherals to the remote unit
- CATx cables (3) from the local unit to the remote unit
- Power adapters to the local and remote unit

Connect:

- DVI MM cable from the computer's DVI out to the local units DVI in port
- USB Type A to Type B cable from the computer's USB port to the local units USB port
- DVI monitor USB keyboard and USB mouse to the remote unit.
- USB peripherals to the remote unit
- CATx cables (3) from the local unit to the remote unit
- Power adapters to the local and remote unit

DO NOT MODIFY THE 4 POSITION SWITCH SETTINGS UNLESS INSTRUCTED TO DO SO BY TECHNICAL SUPPORT

Power up the computer, remote monitor(s), the local and remote CrystalView DVI plus units. You should see the boot-up sequence on the remote monitor(s). Operating the computer is no different that having a local keyboard and mouse directly connected to the computer.

Applications can be run; printing can be performed and standard maintenance done from a remote location.
